

# The Inspector's Review

## The Review Process

- Step 1** - Enclosed is a letter from the Inspector dealing with your case. It gives important information about your case. It also sets out the facts relating to those issues and any questions the Inspector has.
- Step 2** - You now have the opportunity to comment on your case and answer any questions raised. You can also give the Inspector any extra information that you think is important.
- Step 3** - When the Inspector has received your response he or she will make a decision on your case.

## How long will it take?

The quicker you respond to the Inspector, the sooner a decision will be made. The whole process should take no longer than 12 working days.

## What does the Inspector need to know?

It is very important that you read the Inspector's letter and try to answer any questions asked. You should also tell the Inspector if evidence is missing or if there is anything else you think is important. You can reply to the Inspector:

**on the reply form using the enclosed pre-paid envelope; or**

**by telephone on 0808 127 0417. Your call will be free. However, your call may not be free if you use a mobile phone.**
